#### **CASE INFORMATION**

Statement of Answer filed by Respondent on or about: October 29, 2020. UBS Financial Services Inc. signed the Submission Agreement: August 11, 2020.

## **CASE SUMMARY**

In the Statement of Claim, Claimant asserted the following causes of action: violation of the Virginia Securities Act, common law fraud; securities fraud; breach of fiduciary duty; unsuitable recommendations; negligence; negligent supervision; breach of contract; control person liability; and *respondeat superior*. The causes of action relate to investments in UBS Yield Enhancement Strategy (YES).

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Unless specifically admitted in the Statement of Answer, Respondent denied the allegations made in the Statement of Claim and asserted various affirmative defenses.

#### **RELIEF REQUESTED**

In the Statement of Claim, Claimant requested compensatory damages in the amount of \$445,894.00, plus lost income, fees and commissions charged by Respondent, and/or a greater amount as determined by the arbitration Panel; interest assessed up to the time of payment of the award; punitive damages; costs, FINRA fees; attorneys' fees; and such other and further relief as determined by the arbitration Panel.

In the Statement of Answer, Respondent requested that Claimants' claims be dismissed in their entirety with prejudice; expungement of all references to the above-captioned arbitration (Occurrence Number 2086339) from the registration records of Unnamed Party Roderick von Lipsey (CRD Number 4270444), and any and all associated persons who may be affected by this claim, maintained by the Central Registration Depository ("CRD"); and for such other and further relief as the Panel deems just and proper.

#### OTHER ISSUES CONSIDERED AND DECIDED

The Arbitrators acknowledge that they have each read the pleadings and other materials filed by the parties.

During the evidentiary hearing, Respondent did not pursue the expungement request on behalf of Unnamed Party Roderick von Lipsey. Therefore, the Panel made no determination as to Respondent's request for expungement.

The Award in this matter may be executed in counterpart copies.

#### **AWARD**

After considering the pleadings, the testimony and evidence presented at the hearing, and any post-hearing submissions, the Panel has decided in full and final resolution of the issues submitted for determination as follows:

- 1. Respondent is liable for and shall pay to Claimant the sum of \$218,699.29 in compensatory damages.
- 2. Respondent is liable for and shall pay to Claimant the sum of \$8,000.00 in costs.
- 3. Respondent is liable for and shall pay to Claimant the sum of \$72,899.76 in attorneys' fees pursuant to the D.C. Securities Act.
- 4. Respondent is liable for and shall pay to Claimant \$300.00 to reimburse Claimant for the non-refundable portion of Claimant's filing fee previously paid to FINRA Dispute Resolution Services.
- 5. Any and all claims for relief not specifically addressed herein, including any requests for punitive damages, are denied.

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#### **FEES**

Pursuant to the Code of Arbitration Procedure ("Code"), the following fees are assessed:

### Filing Fees
